Rewriting the Record Books: For the second consecutive night, Canada's Janet McLachlan (Vancouver, BC) set a personal best for points in a single game. Her 28 points were two better than the 26 she scored in Canada's Paralympic opener (a 70-59 loss to the Netherlands). Both totals are more than any other Canadian since Australia hosted the Paralympics in 2000. She also established new Canadian benchmarks by making good on Canada's first 20/20 performance (28 points, 21 rebounds), and most free throws (8) in a single game since 2000.

Ouellet the Dogs Out: McLachlan wasn't the only Canadian to etch her name into the record book last night. Cindy Ouellet (Quebec, QC) tallied 10 points and 7 rebounds, while dishing out 9 assists – also a new standard for Canada since 2000.

First Date: This evening's matchup will mark the first time Brazil and Canada have met on the Paralympic court. Both teams will have to get past this unfamiliarity if they hope to claim a win, with a potential birth in the knockout stages at stake.

Are You Experienced?: Of the six returning players with previous Paralympic experience, Kendra Ohama (Calgary, AB) and Tracey Ferguson (Holland Landing, ON) lead Canada's charge. The two veterans are competing in their sixth Paralympic Games, and are looking for their fourth gold medal.

O' Canada: Canada's Senior Women's Team is amongst the most successful and dominant teams in Canadian amateur sport history, capturing three consecutive Paralympic gold medals in 1992, 1996, and 2000, and bronze in 2004. The team currently sits third in the women's world rankings.
