**All Eyes On #12 in 2012:** Canada's #12, Patrick Anderson (Fergus, ON), has been called the greatest wheelchair basketball player of all-time, and for good reason. His emergence on the international scene coincided with Canada winning the first-ever Junior World Championships in 1997. Success followed the dynamic talent to the senior national team, where he led Canada's offense en route to back-to-back Paralympic gold medals in 2000 and 2004. Anderson almost single-handedly propelled Canada past the USA in double-overtime of the Paralympic semi-finals in 2008, but in the end Canada came up just shy of the incredibly rare gold medal three-peat.

**Music to Canadian Ears:** Canada settled for silver in Beijing, and shortly afterwards, star Patrick Anderson (Fergus, ON) announced he was taking a break from wheelchair basketball. After rejoining the team in 2011, Canada became an instant favourite for a fourth-straight podium finish in London. Anderson is one of eight Paralympic athletes from Canada trained in classical music from the Royal Conservatory of Music.

**Never Gets Old:** Canada has a veteran lineup at these Paralympic Games, featuring 11 returning players, nine of whom have previous Paralympic experience. Richard Peter (Duncan, BC), Joey Johnson (Winnipeg, MB), and Dave Durepos (Fredericton, NB) are competing in their fifth Paralympic Games, tying a Canadian record.

**O' Canada:** Canada's Senior Men's Team is amongst the top wheelchair basketball teams in the world. They are the defending silver medallists from the 2008 Beijing Paralympic Games, won back-to-back Paralympic gold medals in 2000 and 2004, and have reached the podium at five of the last six consecutive World Championships.
