**Lending a Helping Hand:** Fergus, Ontario's Patrick Anderson is widely known as pure scorer, but last night's victory over Poland served as an example of how well Anderson can distribute the ball. Anderson dished out 12 assists to go along with his 34 points, setting a Canadian Paralympic record for most individual assists in a game since 2000. Overall, Canada accumulated 27 assists – setting a new team record as the highest total on record since 2000.

**Clash of the Titans:** As co-leaders of Pool B, both Canada and Germany boast 3-0 records. Germany edged Canada in the final of the Papendal Tournament in Holland last month, so look for Canada to exact some revenge. With perfection at stake, only one nation will leave the court with a 4-0 record.

**Never Gets Old:** Canada has a veteran lineup at these Paralympic Games, featuring 11 returning players, nine of whom have previous Paralympic experience. Richard Peter (Duncan, BC), Joey Johnson (Winnipeg, MB), and Dave Durepos (Fredericton, NB) are competing in their fifth Paralympic Games, tying a Canadian record.

**O' Canada:** Canada's Senior Men's Team is amongst the top wheelchair basketball teams in the world. They are the defending silver medallists from the 2008 Beijing Paralympic Games, won back-to-back Paralympic gold medals in 2000 and 2004, and have reached the podium at five of the last six consecutive World Championships.
