**McLachlan Locked In:** Canada's Janet McLachlan (Vancouver, BC) may have been a substitute during her Paralympic debut in 2008, but starting on the bench is a thing of the past for this up-and-coming star. Claiming both the 2011 Wheelchair Basketball Canada Female Athlete of the Year award and MVP honours at the 2012 CWBL Women's National Championships, McLachlan also led all players at the 2010 World Championships in scoring and rebounding, notching seven double-doubles in seven games, and will be looking for more of the same in London.

**New Kids on the Block:** Canada boasts one of the youngest lineups of the tournament, with an average age of 27. Six members of Team Canada - Elaine Allard (St. Eustache, QC), Elisha Williams (Burnaby, BC), Jamey Jewells (Donkin, NS), Jessica Vliegenthart (Victoria, BC), Maude Jacques (Ste-Catherine, QC), and Tamara Steeves (Mississauga, ON) - are Paralympic rookies, and are looking to leave their first Games with a gold medal in tow.

**Are You Experienced?:** Of the six returning players with previous Paralympic experience, Kendra Ohama (Calgary, AB) and Tracey Ferguson (Holland Landing, ON) lead Canada's charge. The two veterans are competing in their sixth Paralympic Games, and are looking for their fourth gold medal.

**O' Canada:** Canada's Senior Women's Team is amongst the most successful and dominant teams in Canadian amateur sport history, capturing three consecutive Paralympic gold medals in 1992, 1996, and 2000, and bronze in 2004. The team currently sits third in the women's world rankings.
