Nothing But Ja-Net: Janet McLachlan (Vancouver, BC) led Canada's offence in their Paralympic opener, notching a double-double (26 points / 15 rebounds) in the team's 70-59 loss to the Netherlands. McLachlan's performance was also a Canadian Paralympic record - her 26-point effort is the highest single-game point total since Misty Thomas scored 21 at the 2000 Paralympic Games. McLachlan will be looking to add to this total in this evening's match.

Aussie Rules: Australia has burst out of the gates at the Paralympic Games, defeating Brazil in a nailbiter, 52-50, and easing past hosts Great Britain, 51-24. Currently ranked fourth in the world (one slot behind Canada), they will look to keep up their perfect tournament record, while Canada will be aiming to enter the win-column. The two teams have only met each other twice in Paralympic play since in the 2000 Games, though they clashed in the gold medal match in Sydney, with Canada taking the spoils, 46-27.

Are You Experienced?: Of the six returning players with previous Paralympic experience, Kendra Ohama (Calgary, AB) and Tracey Ferguson (Holland Landing, ON) lead Canada's charge. The two veterans are competing in their sixth Paralympic Games, and are looking for their fourth gold medal.

O' Canada: Canada's Senior Women's Team is amongst the most successful and dominant teams in Canadian amateur sport history, capturing three consecutive Paralympic gold medals in 1992, 1996, and 2000, and bronze in 2004. The team currently sits third in the women's world rankings.
