2019-2020 Special Project Funding

Special Project Funding is meant to enhance your current program offerings and supplement recruitment events with a goal of increasing participation and offering appropriate programming that aligns with participant needs. This year funding is available for projects that occur between April 1st, 2019 and March 31st, 2020.

Special Project Funding focuses on the early stages of the LTAD model, specifically Active Start and Fundamentals up to the Train to Train stage, in addition to the Competitive/Active for Life stages.

In this year's funding model there are **4 categories**:

1. *Festivals*
2. *Programming*
3. *Technical Development*
4. *Women's Technical Development Presented by Grosso Hooper Law*

You may apply to a **maximum of 2 projects**

To apply → fill out the [APPLICATION FORM](#) once for each project.

To receive funds → upon completion of your project, fill out the [REPORT FORM](#) once for each project and submit relevant documents and receipts.

Please note there are limited funds available. Priority will be given to complete applications that show programs that align with the LTAD and fall under the categories as outlined. **Late and incomplete submissions will not be considered for funding.** Please ensure you complete all areas accurately and contact the WBC Head Office if you have any questions or concerns.

Applicants who wish to make changes to their proposed project must do so in writing no fewer than 2 weeks before the start of the project. Project changes must be approved by the Special Projects Funding Committee before they take place.

[Applications](#) for Special Project Funding are due by the end of the day **August 31, 2019**. **Late and incomplete applications will not be considered.**

[Final reports](#) and receipts are due no later than **March 31, 2019**. **Late reports will not be eligible to receive funding.**

The SPF program will be reviewed on an annual basis. We do anticipate the program will continue to change. We appreciate your feedback throughout this process.
