In 2014, Wheelchair Basketball Canada produced the Wheelchair Basketball Resource Guide for teachers and community partners. The guide is a legacy initiative of the 2014 Women's World Wheelchair Basketball Championship.

The Resource Guide focuses on Grades 1 - 8 and includes activity cards and resources. It is based on the Ontario curriculum guidelines.

New for this year will be resources to support the 2017 Men's U23 World Championship which will be hosted from June 8-16, 2017 at the Mattamy Athletic Centre in downtown Toronto. The new resources will include a list of teams attending the world championship, country flags and Canadian team athlete profiles. When you receive these new resources you can bring the lesson plans related to "Adopt a Country" and "Canada Welcomes the World" to life in your classroom.
