<b>Competition Format</b>	<p>Competition will begin on Friday morning, June 10 with the championship games taking place on Sunday, June 12; followed by the team medal ceremony. Wheelchair Basketball Canada will determine the format of the competition once team attendance is confirmed.</p> <p>Schedule to follow.</p>

Covid-19 Considerations	
<p>The health and safety of Wheelchair Basketball Canada's (WBC) athletes, staff, and community is our priority. WBC supports the use of Health Canada approved vaccines as a key tool in reducing the spread of COVID-19 and its associated health impacts. <b><u>WBC requires all participants to provide proof of full vaccination status.</u></b> (Full vaccination currently requires two separate doses of the Covid-19 vaccine and will need to be completed at a minimum, two weeks or 14 days prior to the date of competition, in compliance with provincial, regional and facility guidelines.)</p> <p>In requiring proof of vaccine status, WBC will follow the guidance of local authorities as well as our partner facilities, which may be more stringent than regional guidelines. We understand that this may vary across the country, and we ask our participants to be respectful of COVID-19 mitigation strategies in their respective regions and facilities, and when travelling outside their local area.</p> <p>As has been the case during the pandemic, WBC will continue to evaluate its guidelines on a regular basis.</p>	
<b>How to keep informed</b>	<p>Official COVID-19 notices will be posted on our website and relayed via email.</p> <p>Team contacts, coaches, players, and parents are also encouraged to follow our social media platforms for related updates.</p> <p><a href="#">Canada</a> <a href="#">PEI</a> <a href="#">Charlottetown Facility</a></p>
<b>Event Hosting Considerations</b>	In an effort to successfully host National Championships amidst the COVID-19 pandemic, WBC may be required to make adjustments to the hosting cities and locations. Teams will be notified of any changes made to the hosting schedule.
<b>Competition</b>	WBC may be required to alter the regulations throughout this process to

Changes may include but are not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Team Roster size</li> <li>• Match operations</li> <li>• Spectator participation</li> <li>• Check-In</li> </ul> <p>Should any changes be implemented, all registered teams will be notified directly.</p>
<p><b>Travel Planning considerations</b></p>	<p><a href="#">PEI Point of Entry – What to expect</a> <a href="#">PEI Pass</a></p> <p>Whereas there will be many unknowns leading up to National Championships, teams are encouraged to book all travel via a certified travel agent to ensure proper support may be provided in case of cancellations or changes to events. Please keep the following in mind when planning travel for National Championships:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure you fully understand the cancellation policy on all travel bookings</li> <li>• Book via our preferred partner, Marlin Travel             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ They have a strong understanding of plans for air carriers accessing various cities</li> <li>○ They have the ability to negotiate better cancellation policies should National Championships be cancelled</li> <li>○ They will contact air carriers directly regarding any major changes which in turn saves teams time and effort</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p><b>Hotel planning considerations</b></p>	<p>Should National Championships be cancelled for COVID-19 reasons, teams will be subject to the hotel’s cancellation policy and will be responsible for any hotel room costs they are not able to cancel or credit.</p>
<p><b>Refund Policy</b></p>	<p>Should National Championships be cancelled by WBC for COVID-19 reasons, teams will receive a full refund of registration fees and performance bonds. Further details will be provided at a later date.</p>
<p><b>Event Protocols</b></p>	<p>Event protocols are in development for each National Championship. Protocols will be circulated prior to the events and tournament protocols will be reviewed at the Coach and Manager Meeting.</p>
