

Event	CWBL National Championship
Date	May 13-15, 2023
Competition Format	At this event there will be two levels of competition as follows:
	<b>National Championship</b> – Open to club and provincial teams playing a 5v5 format. This competition will begin on Saturday morning, May 13 <sup>th</sup> with the championship games taking place on Monday, May 15 <sup>th</sup> ; followed by the team medal ceremony.
	This competition can accommodate up to 16 teams. If there are more than 12 teams entered in the competition, efforts will be made to separate the teams into three divisions based on coach feedback and preferred level of competition. This preference can be communicated on the Roster Form.
	<b>Recreational Competition</b> – Open to individuals* and teams playing a 3x3 format. This competition will begin on Saturday morning, May 13 <sup>th</sup> with the final games taking place on Sunday, May 14 <sup>th</sup> ; If there are more than 6 teams entered in the Recreational Competition, efforts will be made to separate the teams into divisions based on coach feedback and preferred level of competition. This preference can be communicated on the Roster Form.
	ALL TEAMS ARE WELCOME, and ATHLETES MAY PLAY IN BOTH THE 5v5 AND 3x3 COMPETITION IF THEY CHOOSE

Hotel planning	Should National Championships be cancelled for any reason, teams will
