	<b>Recreational</b> – Open to individuals* and teams playing a 3x3 format. This competition will begin on Saturday morning, April 15 <sup>th</sup> with the championship games taking place on Sunday, April 16 <sup>th</sup> ; followed by the team medal ceremony.
	*Individual players may enter the recreational division and will be placed on a team prior to the first game on April 15. To enter as an individual, please contact the <b>Provincial Sport Organization</b> in your area.
	<b>Development Clinic</b> – Open to all female participants and coaches.
